We would like to remind parents that the school gate is open between 8.30am and 8.45am. **Pupils must be in school & ready to learn by 8.45am at the very latest.**

A pupil being late to start the day not only has an impact on the child but is disruptive for the teaching staff and the class as a whole.

In addition, it is very disruptive to the start of the working day for staff if there are constant interruptions from pupils arriving after 8.45am.

Over 22% of pupils were late into school on Thursday morning last week & Friday morning this week & have been recorded as such on the registers. This is an unacceptable level of late arrivals so we would be grateful for your support in rectifying this.

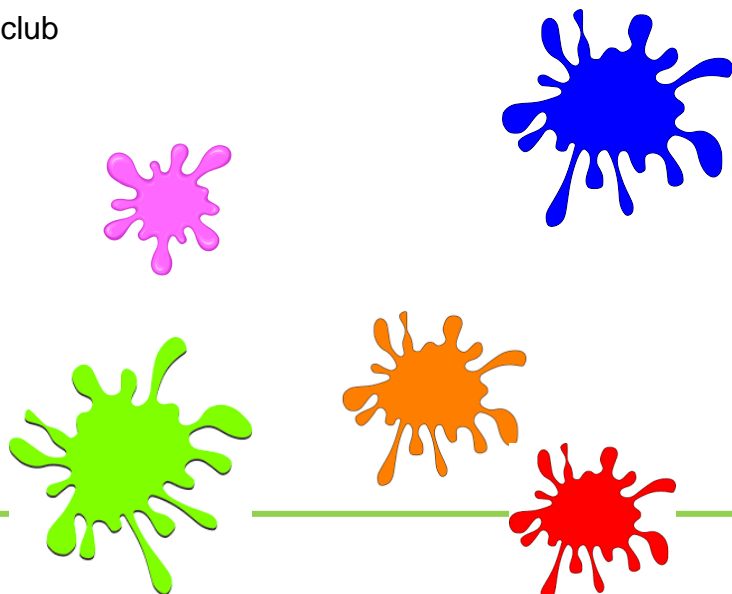
Sports week this year will be held the week of Monday 7th – Friday 12th July.
