All children will be coming home today with a book mark & the Reception children have a new library card.

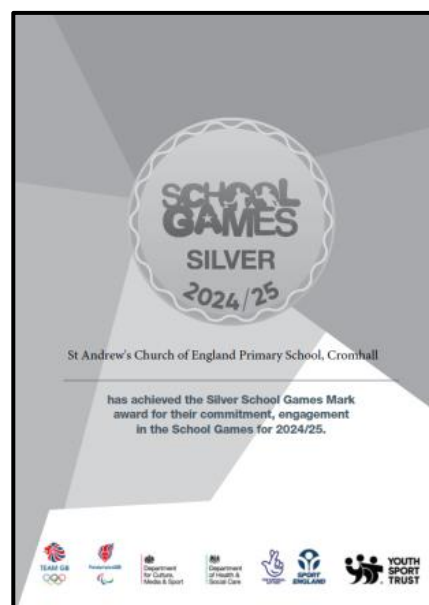
Sport
