<p><u>Roman Gods</u> Create a fact file or PowerPoint on the Roman Gods. This should include details about at least 5 gods.</p>	<p><u>Soldier or Warrior?</u> Research and draw a Roman soldier or a Celtic warrior. Label their uniform, equipment and weapons</p>	<p><u>Roman Numerals</u> Choose a times table that you have learnt and write it out using Roman numerals.</p>
<p><u>Roman Invention</u> Research a Roman invention that is still used today. E.g. Roads, aqueduct, sewage systems, central heating. Use Microsoft Word to produce a fact page about the invention.</p>	<p><u>Roman Emperors</u> Write a list of 5 different Roman Emperors and the dates of their reign.</p>	<p><u>Toga</u> The Roman's wore togas. With a friend or family member, see if you can work out how to make a toga. (Take a photo of you wearing it!)</p>
<p><u>Roman Artefacts</u> Draw or paint a picture of a Roman artefact. E.g. Oil lamp, bust, coin, chariot, etc</p>	<p><u>Roman or Celt?</u> Would you prefer to be a Roman or a Celt? Explain in detail which one you would choose and give 4 reasons for your choices.</p>	<p><u>Rome</u> Create a fact file or PowerPoint about the city of Rome. It should include at least 5 details about what you can find in Rome.</p>
