In Year 1 and 2, the children are expected to be able to read and write the common exception words linked to their year group (please see the enclosed list).

During our Phonics lessons, we focus on a certain group of these words each week, helping to build the children's capabilities in being able to read and write these independently.

Whilst we don't have formal spelling tests at this age, it would be helpful if you could support your child's learning at home by looking at the following spellings with them. We have split these up into groups of words that will be the focus each week.

- Paint the words
- Draw the words in sand
- Paint the words in water on a fence
- Make the words out of playdough
- Scramble the words for your child to unscramble
- Look at the word, write the word, check the word
- Make a word search with the words
- Use magnetic letters to write the words
- Get a whiteboard and marker to practise writing the words
- Use the words in a sentence
- Write the words out using different coloured pens/pencils
- Circle the tricky part of the word that is hard to learn
- Write the words out incorrectly - can your child correct the words?
