

# POSSIBLE SCENARIOS

**There are 3 scenarios to be ready for...**

1. Whole bubble told to isolate including the teacher who does not have symptoms
  2. Whole bubble told to isolate but the teacher is too ill to teach.
  3. Individual children told to isolate as a family member has symptoms.

# SCENARIO 1 – WHOLE BUBBLE TOLD TO ISOLATE AND THE TEACHER IS ABLE TO TEACH

## What to expect...

- The year group schedule will be emailed out to parents on the first day of isolation.
- Live lessons will start from day 2.
- Invitations for live lessons will be emailed the day before each lesson
- Live lessons will be taught over Microsoft Teams daily, times on following page. Live lessons will alternate between English and maths. Oak Academy will be used for the other lessons.
- Specific feedback will be emailed to families of children who have shared their learning via email with their teacher.
- At the end of each school day there will be an online session to celebrate learning and share a class story.  
(Reception: 2:20, Y1&2: 2:40, Y3&4: 3:00, Y5&6: 3:20)
- Once a week, there will be an online drop-in support session for 1 hour for 1:1 support. A link will be emailed to be used when necessary. Children will wait in the virtual waiting room for their turn. This hour of support will be on Thursday at 11am.
- If your child is on the Special Educational Needs register, additional support will be sent to you by the second day and you will receive a phone call by the SENCo during their time at home.

# SCENARIO 2 – WHOLE BUBBLE TOLD TO ISOLATE BUT THE TEACHER IS TOO ILL TO TEACH

## What to expect...

- Your child will be given a printed pack from school with activities to complete along with a *suggested* timetable
- No live lessons will happen
- Parent will receive a weekly phone call from the school to check in and answer any queries regarding their child's learning.
- If your child is on the Special Educational Needs register, additional support will be sent to you by the second day and you will receive a phone call by the SENCo / Headteacher during their time at home.

# SCENARIO 3 – INDIVIDUAL CHILDREN TOLD TO ISOLATE AS A FAMILY MEMBER HAS SYMPTOMS

## What to expect...

- Your child's class teacher will contact you to check in with you, answer any questions and ensure you have all the resources you need at home
  - Your child's teacher will send home English and maths activities, linked to the learning in class.
  - You will receive an invitation to join in with the weekly celebration worship on Thursdays.
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
