



## Parents' evening

You should have all by now received an email from your child's class teacher about parents evening. Please see below guidelines for the meetings.

To support everybody in the smooth running of these appointments, please be aware of the following:

- Appointments are NOT to be recorded (on any device).
- Ensure you are able to mute and unmute, including your video screen.
- Please ensure you are able to use Teams on your device before the appointment day.
- Be conscious of background environments and others in the room. Please ensure the session is carried out in an appropriate place with a neutral background.
- Staff, parents and pupils (if attending) will wear suitable clothing, as should anyone else in the household.
- Language must be professional and appropriate, including any family members in the background.
- Please note if you are late for the appointment, you can still join in during your allocated slot. Please bear in mind that sessions will not go over the given time allocated, as this will have an impact on other appointments.
- A waiting room system will be in use and staff will be able to admit you into the meeting at the start of your session.
- Sometimes, due to circumstances beyond our control, your appointment may start later than planned. During this time, you will be in a waiting room. Teachers will know you are waiting and will admit you as soon as they are able to.

## Skipping Workshops - Monday 10th May 2021

We are delighted to inform you that we have invited 'Skipping Workshops' to work with our school, teaching different skipping skills to every class.

Skipping Workshops have presented demonstrations in over 2000 schools, represented Great Britain in international skipping events and appeared on many TV shows.

Their aim is to encourage children and adults to skip for health, fun and fitness, whilst introducing modern and traditional skipping games including individual rope tricks, speed skills and Double Dutch, back into the playground and into the PE curriculum.

The PTFA have kindly purchased ropes for skipping in school which the children are very much enjoying using. If your child/children would like to purchase a rope for home use then the same high quality '**speed ropes**' as used by the international team, will be on sale at school at a **reduced** cost of **£5.00**.

The ropes are made to a high standard, are light and turn easily to allow children and adults to progress rapidly. Colour change solar ropes are **£6**. Adult ropes are also available for taller children, older siblings and your personal fitness/weight loss etc at **£6** each, 4m 'family ropes' at **£7.50** each and 2 x 4m Double Dutch set for **£12**.
