Important information regarding COVID 19

- The advice that all schools have received is that we no longer have to advise parents of any single confirmed cases of COVID 19. This is the advice from Public Health England of which we are being asked to adhere to.
- Positive cases must isolate for 10 days. All family members with COVID symptoms should take the PCR test. Children under the age of 11 should not be given a LFT test.
- Family members without symptoms and who have a negative PCR test result do not need to isolate if they have been double vaccinated or are under the age of 18 years and 6 months

Physical Education

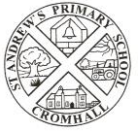
